



SSG Hosts BOB, IDB Presentation Rounds by Dylan Tanyag

The Supreme Student Government (SSG) conducted the presentation rounds for its annual Battle of the Bands (BOB) and Indak Dance Battle (IDB) themed *'Beats and Voices: Unleashing Student Potential'* to showcase students' collective talents in music and dance on October 24 at the Edgar V. Bondoc Gymnasium.
