



PTA-BOD Facilitates Leadership Training Seminar by Reisha Castillo

The PTA Board of Directors organized a training seminar themed ***'Leadership Capacity'*** to strengthen the leadership skills of its members alongside the Homeroom Parent-Teacher Association Presidents and Vice Presidents at the Audio Visual Room on November 1.

Serving as the resource speaker of the session, the school principal, **Dr. Alexander S. Acosta**, focused on the theme *'Attitude Matters,'* wherein he discussed the importance of effective collaboration. Further, the session featured interactive activities aimed at building teamwork, communication, and leadership skills among participants. He shared,

"No man will make a great leader who wants to do it himself or to get all the credit for doing it."

Additionally, Dr. Acosta outlined the various categories of services that leaders can offer, underscoring how selfless service motivates a leader to act. He also emphasized the integration

of empathy and honesty in teamwork, rather than self-serving service that prioritizes the leader's personal interests.
