Out of a total of 182 entries submitted by schools across the Philippines and overseas, students from Philippine School Doha secured the title of overall champions in two distinct divisions of the Aralinks Quest ShowcACE competition. In the Primary Division's Physical Computing Computational Artifacts Track, **Quiann Abrigonda, Rikka Bernados, and Selena Labastida** were declared overall champions with their winning project titled '*C.A.R.E. Companion for Awareness, Resilience, and Empathy, "Dr. CARE, the Talking Doll Therapist That Supports Mental Health,"*' under the guidance of Mr. Vincent Go and Ms. Beverly Presingcula.

Further, in the Intermediate Division's Software-based Computational Artifacts Track, **Prince Bonsol and Ma. Jia Nepomuceno** was also named overall champion for their project, 'One Community, One Mission,' under the guidance of their coach, Mr. Aries Paco.

Both teams are allowed to represent the school and showcase their work at the upcoming awarding ceremony, *the 9th Aralinks Leadership Academy Solidifying Goals, Inspiring Action (ALAGA)*, which is set to take place on November 21, 2025 at the Royce Hotel & Casino in Clark, Pampanga, where they will be formally recognized and their winning projects will be displayed at the ALAGA Playground.
