PSD Harry Kieswetter Learning Resource Center celebrated the 90th National Book Week celebration with the theme, '*Read, Dream, Celebrate*' through a book fair at the PSD Ground floor hallway, and various competitions held at the PSD HK-LRC Library and PSD Audio-Visual Room from November 3-20.

The vice principal of the Quality Assurance and Accreditation Department and officer-in-charge for the school principal **Dr. Lorina S. Villanueva** gave her opening remarks during the book week culmination program where she recognized the efforts of those who actively participated in the programs, projects, and contests adapted by the library.
