

PSD 32ND FOUNDATION DAY COMMEMORATED

Philippine School Doha gathered in commemoration of its 32nd Founding Anniversary with the theme, *'Empowering Excellence, Serving Beyond Boundaries'* under the spearhead of the Senior High School Department on October 4 at the Open Court and Edgar V. Bondoc Gymnasium.
