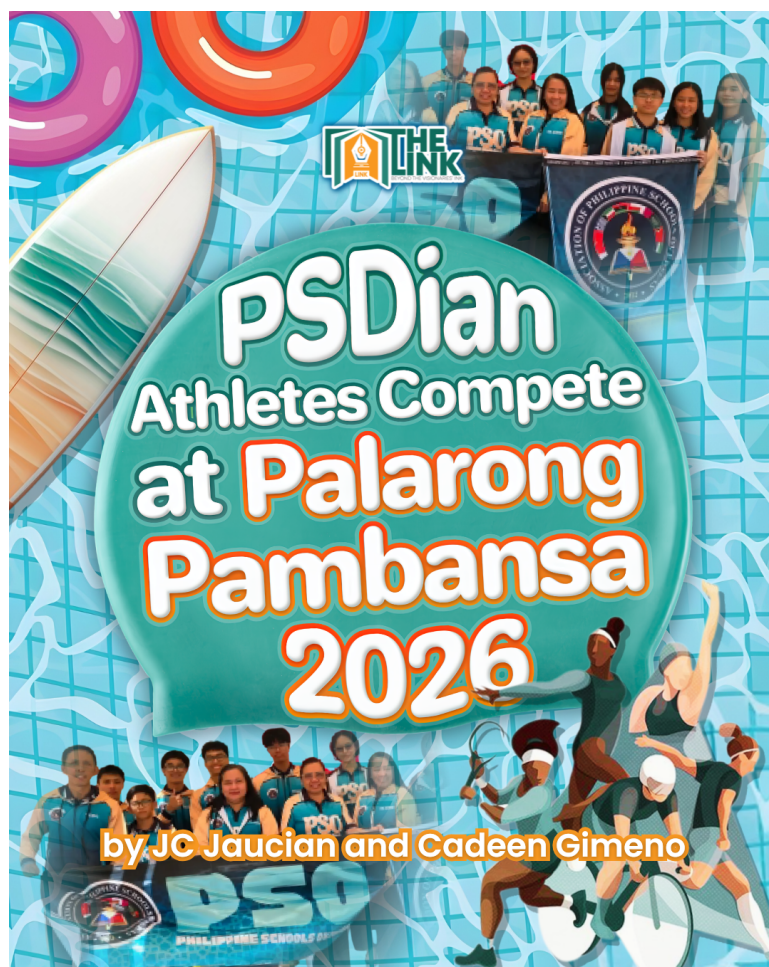




PSDian Athletes Compete at Palarong Pambansa 2026
