“Being with your family is so precious.”

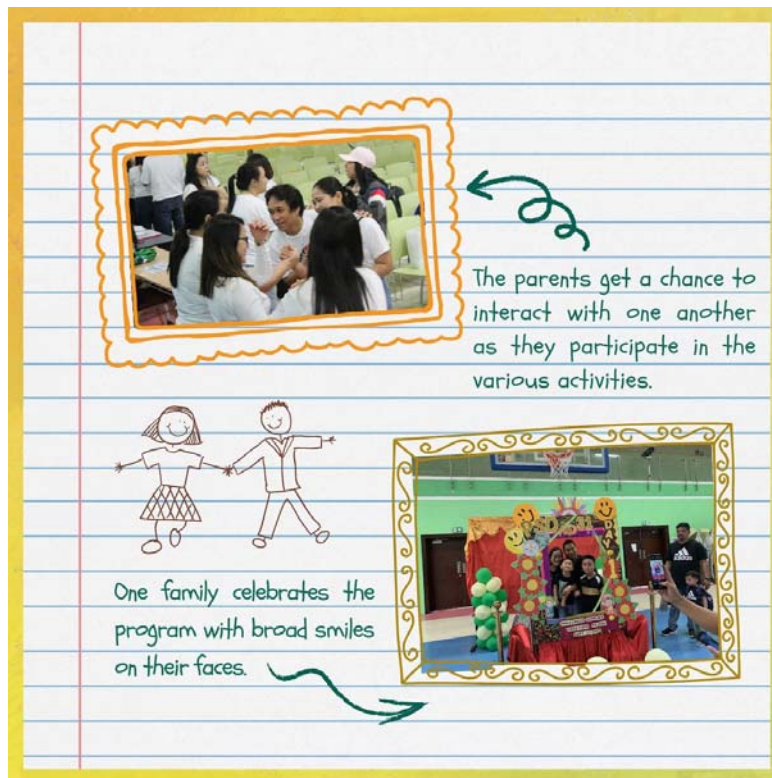
