Each Preschool section had one pair representative and with the concept of 'Adopt-a-candidate,' other sections throughout the school voted to show their support toward their assigned candidate.

Teacher **Apphia A. Laroa**, the chairperson of the event, shared that though the preparation and production of the event was challenging, it was all worth it in the end. She further elaborated,

"Their (the candidates) confidence really developed, and then they tried to get out of their shell. You can really see that the development is there. That is already a big impact for the children, especially when making friends with the other students."
