Moreover, **Fretz Dones** was awarded the Volleyball Boys Most Valuable Player as he was instrumental in snatching the Championship against the Blue Eagles. Along with him, the Mythical Six also included **Keone Samonteza** (White Hawks), **Florence Seda** (Red Tamaraws), **Shawn Aquino** and **Earl Tan** (Blue Eagles), and **Sean Dacutanan** (Yellow Tigers).

Concurrently, in a dazzling display of dominance at the Girls Volleyball court, **Leila Gonzales** of the White Hawks was awarded the Most Valuable player, making an edge over the others in the Mythical Six, namely: **Joana Lopez** (Red Tamaraws), **Shellah Sotejo** (Yellow Tigers), **Gabrielle Diestro** and **Erika Paderon** (Blue Eagles), and **Joie Salvatin** (White Hawks).
